**Week One Prompt (Jan 5):** “And things are 'bout to get real good.”

Credit: Lyric from the song Me Without You by Gwen Stefani.

I chose this lyric because Gwen is the coolest! It's a great attitude to have as we jump into a new year. And it has a hint of sass mixed in with a positive outlook.

**Week Two Prompt (Jan 12):** “You should see me in a crown.”
